Herewith I present to your attention the first issue of the magazine «Russia & World: Scientific Dialogue». Although the market for humanitarian scientific magazines in our country today is extensive, it seems to me that the magazine will fill its own niche differing from other periodicals of a similar profile. First, according to the intention of the founder and with a general orientation towards the processes taking place in international life, it will be distinguished by an interdisciplinary character. Third, the very name of the magazine is to emphasize, that our attention will be focused on the regional and global role of Russia, its relations with various partners in the international arena and its interests abroad. Fourth, our priority attention will be paid to joint research of Russian and foreign scientists. We hope to promote the development of cooperation between domestic scientists and our colleagues abroad and bring their point of view to a foreign audience. Finally, the pages of our magazine will be always open for publication of novice authors submitting new, interesting ideas for further discussion and research.

The magazine will publish the most interesting materials of international forums, conferences and round tables, as well as reviews of some of the latest scientific works that are relevant to our profile and the intended orientation.
